# Minutes of the Meeting of Langford Budville Parish Council held on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at 6.30pm at the Jubilee Hall

#### **Public Forum**

Cllr Mansell gave his update including details of the Somerset Council budget deficit, planning policy consultation and phosphate proposal. He will also circulate details on bus service changes to Councillors for comment.

Jon Moise-Souch, new head of Langford Budville School, gave a short presentation on the aims for his role and his plans to develop the school including potential preschool and £30k investment in Early Years. Councillors asked if there was anything the Parish Council can do to support the important village asset. Parking issues were discussed and the Chair will approach the Martlett. Mr Moise-Souch was thanked by the Chair for his very positive update.

Two members of the public presented a proposal on 20 mph speed limit in Runnington. A list of issues was given to the Parish Council and to Cllr Mansell. Juliet is meeting with a representative from Somerset Council Highways on 15<sup>th</sup> September to discuss Highways issues and will update the members of public and the Parish Council on the outcome.

The Clerk reported that, following contact with Wellington Without PC, the Harpford Bridge fingerpost just outside the parish boundary had been righted.

Josh Wedderkopp was thanked for his work on the website.

Somerset Wildlife Trust have contacted the Parish Council to advise that the short trail on the reserve is now fully open again. The last of the ash felled in the winter has been extracted and the ruts levelled.

#### 4.1 A Greener Langford Budville

#### 4.2 Triangle

Following discussion on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September about the boundary fence issue it was decided that the Parish Council should hold back to getting hedging from woodland trust until other options have been fully explored/ agreed. This included getting a replacement fence costed and then looking into possible grants for this.

Interim repairs to fencing around play area and where possible other rails were undertaken on the 9th September to ensure that next inspection of playground passes.

After approval at the last meeting, the Clerk has purchased four 150 x 200mm signs from the Sign Shed at a cost of £5.16 each to remind parishioners of the no dogs rule. The Chair will put these up.

The Chair has also fitted toggles to the noticeboard.

#### 4.4 Conservation Group. Jubilee Wood and Wildflower area
